SCOTIA FIZZ

bacardi, sandeman fine tawny port,
lemon juice, egg white, seltzer 10.

*Alexander Lindsey Glen named his new home
"Nova Scotia" meaning "New Scotland" when he
settled on the north side of the Mohawk River.*

88 SPRITZ

aperol, prosecco, orange twist 10.

*Glen Sanders Mansion switched hands several
times over the decades until it was purchased
by Angelo Mazzone in 1988.*

MOHAWK 75

hendrick's gin, blackberry liqueur,
fresh lemon juice, prosecco,
frozen butterfly pea tea ice 14.

*John Glen was an agent for the Dutch West India Co.
The Mohawk Valley was a well-traveled pathway
for the trappers from the North.*

EAST WING MULE

kettle one vodka, gosling's ginger beer,
infused lime water 10.

*In 1713, Glen's son expanded the house by adding the
East Wing, which is now where The Lounge is located.*

THE GLEN WORD

green chartreuse liqueur, orange liqueur,
fresh lime juice, maraschino cherry 12.

*Did you know there was never a man by the name
Glen Sanders? The Mansion is named for two families
who were an integral part of this area's history.*

SMOKEY HONG KONG

johnnie walker red, sweet vermouth,
dry vermouth, luxardo, lemon peel,
smoked on a cedar board 14.

*Glen Sanders Mansion was the first home locally to
smoke their meats indoors. This occurred on the
3rd floor of the mansion.*
